Michael David Most, M.D., Joins Allied Surgical Group

Most Brings Latest Head and Neck Surgical Options to Northern New Jersey

MORRISTOWN, N.J. (Dec. 2, 2008) — Allied Surgical Group (www.alliedsurgical.org) has announced that Michael David Most, M.D., a board-certified general surgeon specializing in surgery of the head and neck, has joined the practice. He is an attending surgeon at Morristown Memorial Hospital.

Dr. Most is qualified in advanced surgical techniques, including noninvasive laparoscopic and sentinel-node cancer treatment. He is among the first in the area to offer endoscopic thyroid surgery, a minimally invasive procedure that was developed to reduce the pain and the neck scarring that can be associated with conventional thyroid surgery. He has also received special training in head and neck surgical oncology; benign head and neck disease; salivary, thyroid and parathyroid disease; and microvascular reconstruction.

Dr. Most expands the head and neck expertise at Allied Surgical Group, currently led by William L. Diehl, M.D., F.A.C.S., a board-certified cancer specialist and general surgeon with Allied Surgical Group and an attending surgeon at Morristown Memorial Hospital.

According to Dr. Diehl, “The addition of Dr. Most at Allied Surgical Group makes state-of-the-art head and neck surgery available to even more patients in northern New Jersey. Our group strives to bring the latest surgical options to the area to ensure that patients have many options available to them close to home.”

Dr. Most earned his medical degree at Technion Israel Institute of Technology, Haifa, Israel. He completed his surgery residency and a fellowship in head and neck oncologic and microvascular reconstructive surgery at Beth Israel Medical Center in New York City. He also holds a Master of Arts in biomedical sciences from the Barry Z. Levine School of Health Sciences at Touro College, Dix Hills, N.Y.

Dr. Most has authored or co-authored a variety of peer-reviewed research papers and presented his research at several medical conferences. He earned the Ginzberg “Chief of the Year” Award and the Junior Resident Clinical Achievement Award and was also named administrative chief resident at Beth Israel Medical Center.

He has served on several important committees at Beth Israel, including the Surgical Quality Improvement Committee, the Medical Board Surgical Committee and the Residency House Staff Committee. He also served on the Physician Advisory Committee for Clinical Information Systems with the Continuum Health Care Network. He is active in the New York Head and Neck Society.
